

# How do I download a Kaltura Video in Canvas?

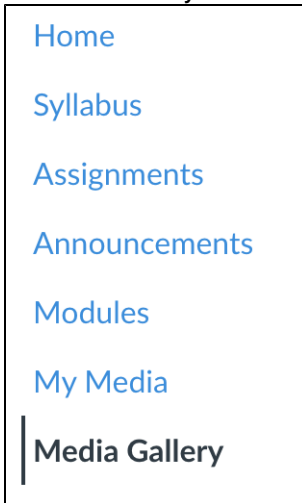
## Tell Me

These instructions are for students or other non-video owners to download Kaltura videos uploaded to My Media in Canvas. If you are the owner of the video and wish to download, please see [How can I download my video from My Media in Canvas?](#)



Please note that these instructions assume the video has been [marked as downloadable](#) by the video owner.

1. Login to [Canvas](#) and access a course
2. Select **Media Gallery**

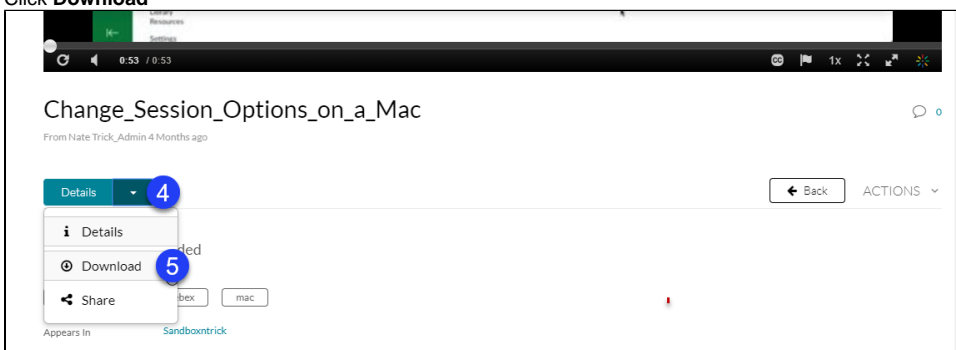


3. Click the video you wish to download. In this example we clicked **The Indoor Generation**



4. Click on the **Details** button under the title


5. Click **Download**



6. You will then see the available formats to download. Click the **Download icon** for the format you wish to download



7. Depending on your browser, you may be prompted to allow the download. Please click **Allow** if you get a pop-up for this video download
8. The video will begin to download
9. Go to your downloaded items to view the video file
10. Make sure to save it in a specified location
11. Repeat steps 2-7 for each remaining video
