

# I am teaching a hybrid course and see multiple sections, which Canvas course should I use?

## Tell Me

The Registrar split hybrid courses into sub-sections (child sections) depending on the course meeting days. For Monday, Wednesday, Friday courses, there are three (3) child sections. For Tuesday, Thursday courses, there are two (2) child sections. The child sections have also been combined into one course in Canvas. All parent, child, and combined courses are listed in Canvas on the All Courses page and may also appear on your Canvas Dashboard

1. You will see all the child sections in Canvas in addition to the combined course
  - a. You are teaching course XXXX-1234-001 that meets on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday
    - i. The original course is split into 3 child sections. The sections are labeled Y01, Y02, and Y03. You will see the following courses in Canvas:  
202080-Fall 2020z-Mon Only-XXXX-1234-Y01  
202080-Fall 2020z-Wed Only-XXXX-1234-Y02  
202080-Fall 2020z-Fri Only-XXXX-1234-Y03
    - ii. The child sections are combined into one course that you can use to create content and give students access to. You will see the following course in Canvas that you should create in content and give students access to:  
202080-Fall 2020-Combined-XXXX-1234-Y01:XXXX-1234-Y02:XXXX-1234-Y02
  - b. You are teaching course XXXX-1235-001 that meets on Tuesday and Thursday.
    - i. These courses will follow the same format as the Monday, Wednesday, Friday courses listed above but without section Y03  
202080-Fall 2020z-Tue Only-XXXX-1235-Y01  
202080-Fall 2020z-Thu Only-XXXX-1235-Y02
    - ii. The child sections are united into one combined course. You will see the following course in Canvas that you should create content in and give students access to:  
202080-Fall 2020-Combined-XXXX-1235-Y01:XXXX-1235-Y02
2. If you are teaching a cross-listed/combined course, the following new child and combined courses are available to you in Canvas:
  - a. You are teaching courses XXXX-1234-001 and YYYY-1234-001 that meets on Tuesday and Thursday
    - i. The original courses are split into 2 child sections, labeled Y01 and Y02. You will see the following courses in Canvas:  
202080-Fall 2020z-Tue Only-XXXX-1234-Y01  
202080-Fall 2020z-Thu Only-XXXX-1234-Y02  
202080-Fall 2020z-Tue Only-YYYY-1234-Y01  
202080-Fall 2020-z-Thu Only-YYYY-1234-Y02
    - ii. All child sections are combined into one course. You will see the following courses in Canvas:  
202080-Fall 2020-Combined-XXXX-1234-Y01:XXXX-1234-Y02  
202080-Fall 2020-Combined-YYYY-1234-Y01:YYYY-1234-Y02
    - iii. All the child sections are combined into one course that you can use to create content in and give students access to. You will see the following in Canvas:  
202080-Fall 2020-Combined-XXXX-1234-Y01:XXXX-1234-Y02:YYYY-1234-Y01:YYYY-1234-Y02\_Combined
