

# How do I embed a Google Form on my website?

## Tell Me

1. The Google Form must be public in order to embed it on a website
  - a. Click **Settings** (gear icon) in the upper right corner
  - b. **Uncheck** the "Restrict to users in UNC Charlotte and its trusted organizations" box

3. On the edit page, click the **Source** button on the editor toolbar and paste the embed code into the text area - click **Save**
